Ellahi will pilot one of the team's Porsche Cayman 718 GT4 RS Clubsport entries, carrying car number 25 throughout the 2026 season.

Ismaeel, an established sim racer, who calls Mountain Lakes, New Jersey home, joins CSM after competing in 2025 mainly in European GT4 championships also driving a Porsche GT4 RS Clubsport.
