Czabok-Simpson Motorsport takes delivery of first Porsche 718 GT4 RS Clubsport for 2024 season.



Indianapolis, IN (August 30th, 2023)

Czabok-Simpson Motorsport (CSM), a new team formed earlier this year by long-time IMSA competitor Stephen Simpson and current JDC-Miller MotorSports Head of Corporate Development Matthias Czabok stand next to the first of two Porsche 718 GT4 RS Clubsports, which the new team purchased and plans to run in 2024.

The duo also announced a partnership with Indianapolis based LAP Motorsports led by Luis Perocarpi and Rob Ridgely who will handle the race operations part of the new program.

The new team will be headquartered in Indianapolis and took delivery of its first car last week. The teams' second Porsche 718 GT4 RS Clubsport is due to be delivered in November this year.

"Obviously, this is a very exciting step and a new challenge on many levels," said Simpson. "Matthias and I have known each other for a long time from the years when I was driving for JDC-Miller and we always talked about doing something together. I have already worked with and actually raced for Luis and Rob when LAP Motorsports ran the MINI John Cooper Works team in IMSA. They run a great operation, so I am looking forward to the four of us doing this program together."

For Czabok this will not be the first time being a team owner, he was a minor part owner in Larry Blairs Champcar program Blair Racing in the early 2000.

"Stephen and I have known each other since 2013 when we were actually spotting at LOR for JDC's Road to Indy Pro Mazda program. Then when JDC-Miller started to run in the new IMSA WeatherTech Championship, Stephen was one of the teams' first drivers. We won many races together at JDC-Miller over a number of seasons, in Dpi, LMPC and TCR. I think Stephen's talent and skills behind the wheel is a big asset for our team, but he also always saw the bigger picture and the commercial side of things; he understands what it takes to make a program successfull; so I am really looking forward to the opportunities of our new team.," commented Czabok.

Czabok continued,

"All four of us have known each other for a while so CSM is the culmination of a lot of long term planning and with Stephen and Luis being Indianapolis residents, as well as it being the home of some of our commercial partners, it made sense to base the team in the *Racing Capital of the World*. I think we each bring different, complimentary skillsets to the team as well as a whole lot of experience. We'll also be leveraging Stephen's extensive track record in driver development as a key strength. Right now we're taking it one step at a time as there's are a lot of moving parts at the moment but we have big ambitions for 2024 and the future."

"Lot's of good conversations are happening right now," said Simpson. "Obviously the beauty about GT4 is that there are a plenty of championship options, IMSA alone has two great series' with the IMSA Michelin Pilot Challenge Championship and the VP Racing SportsCar Challenge, and then there is also SRO with GT4 America and of course, the Porsche Sprint Challenge. GT4 is a customer oriented category and we have great customer support from Porsche NA. The 718 GT4 RS Clubsport is an amazing car and we are looking to finalize with a couple of funded drivers in the next couple of weeks." Simpson continued.

Czabok-Simpson Motorsport will announce additional team and commercial partners, as well as drivers for the program in the near future.
