Czabok-Simpson Motorsport is expanding to a two-car Michelin Pilot Challenge GS program starting with round two of the 2024 Championship at Sebring International Raceway as part of the Mobil One 12 Hours of Sebring event.

Indianapolis based Czabok-Simpson Motorsport confirmed today that it will expand its current Porsche Michelin Pilot Challenge GS program to two cars starting with the second round of the 2024 Championship at Sebring International Raceway as part of the Mobil One 12 Hours of Sebring event. Chicago native Gordon Scully and Indianapolis native Jackson Lee will pilot the Czabok-Simpson Motorsport entered # 2 Porsche 718GT4 RS CS, and will join the # 67 sister entry driven by Sebastian Carazo and Nikita Lastochkin.

Gordon Scully was already part of the teams Michelin Pilot Challenge # 67 three driver line-up entry at the season opening round at Daytona International Speedway in January.

Jackson Lee, a Speed Group Career Advancement Program driver, drove the teams # 66 Porsche in the IMSA VP Racing Sportscar Challenge during the ROAR BEFORE THE ROLEX 24 season opening two rounds, and qualifying 4th and 6th out of the competitive 22 car field, he went on to record a 6th and 7th place finishes for the two 45-minute sprints races for the number 66 car.

Lee has now expanded his 2024 debut IMSA season to include select Michelin Pilot Challenge races with Czabok-Simpson Motorsport, the Michelin Pilot Challenge Championship is IMSA's top support series for the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship.

The 21-year-old from Indiana will now make his Michelin Pilot Challenge debut in round two at Sebring International Raceway as part of the Mobil One 12 Hours of Sebring event, on March 13th-15th, in the #2 Czabok-Simpson Motorsport Porsche and will be teamed with another "Road to Indy" veteran and IMSA rookie, Gordon Scully. Additional 2024 Michelin Pilot Challenge events for Lee include Mid-Ohio, Canadian Tire Motorsports Park, the Indianapolis Motor Speedway and Road Atlanta.

The IMSA Michelin Pilot Challenge Championship is the top support series in IMSA with multiple manufacturers offering two classes – Grand Sport (GS) with GT4 cars and Touring Car Racing (TCR) – running a 10-race schedule in combination with most of the WeatherTech Championship events. Each weekend event includes a single race of either two or four hours with two drivers and the option of adding a third driver for the four-hour races.
