**Gordon Scully to return to Czabok-Simpson Motorsport (CSM) in 2025 for full season IMSA Michelin Pilot Challenge campaign.**

Czabok-Simpson Motorsport (CSM) is pleased to announce that Chicago native Gordon Scully will return for the team's 2025 IMSA full-season Michelin Pilot Challenge program.

Scully, 24 made the switch from open wheel cars to sports cars with Czabok-Simpson Motorsport (CSM) in 2024, competing strongly in five selected races with the teams' No 67 and No 2 entries in the Michelin Pilot Challenge championship and will step up with the team again in 2025 for the full 10 race season schedule.

The 10 race 2025 Michelin Pilot Challenge championship schedule, kicks off on January 23rd – 26th, with a four-hour race at Daytona International Speedway, Daytona Beach, FL, following the official three day "ROAR BEFORE THE ROLEX 24" test season the week before on January 17th – 19th.

**Gordon Scully, 24**, from Chicago Illinois, made his transition into sports car racing in 2024 from single-seater, US open wheel racing. A graduate of the Lucas Oil School of Racing and the Formula Race Promotions F1600 programs, Gordon competed in the 2023 USF2000 Championship, finishing 15<sup>th</sup> in the highly competitive 34 car field, before joining Czabok-Simpson Motorsport (CSM) in 2024 for five races in the IMSA Michelin Pilot Challenge Championship.

Daytona and Watkins Glen IMSA Prototype winner and Czabok-Simpson Motorsport (CSM) team co-owner, Stephen Simpson says, “Very excited to have Gordon continuing with us in our 2025 IMSA Michelin Pilot Challenge campaign. Gordon was very competitive in the races he did with us in our maiden 2024 season in the IMSA Michelin Pilot Challenge Championship, especially considering that a lot of the tracks were new for him and this was the first time he drove a GT style race car. So we are really looking forward to have him back with us in 2025.”

“I’m super happy to be able to remain with CSM in 2025 and sign for a full season in the Michelin Pilot Challenge championship. Getting a first taste of IMSA sports car racing this season with the five races we did just confirmed to me I was in the right place. The team have made the transition so easy for me and we are all hungry for success. I don’t think people realise just how competitive the Michelin Pilot Challenge championship is which obviously makes it even more fun to compete there. We were right in contention on a number of occasions in 2024 and I think we showed a lot of potential in running upfront in several races, so for sure we will have a lot of momentum for the 2025 season”, commented Gordon Scully.

CSM will announce Scully team mates in the next couple of weeks as well as other entries and championship the team plans to participate in for the 2025 season.
