Indianapolis Native Jackson Lee joins Czabok-Simpson Motorsport for IMSA VP Racing SportsCar Challenge



Indianapolis, IN (December 19th, 2023)

Czabok-Simpson Motorsport has signed "Road to Indy" veteran Jackson Lee for the IMSA VP Racing SportsCar Challenge which kicks off the 2024 IMSA season at The Roar Before The Rolex 24 in Daytona, January 19th to 21st.For Lee, who was a 2020 Team USA Scholarship winner and spent most of three seasons in USF 2000 and USF Pro 2000, this will be his debut outing in IMSA sports car racing after being a multiple race winner in single-seater formula cars and a one-off appearance in TC America in 2023.

The six event (12-race) 2024 VP Racing SportsCar Challenge championship begins with a pair of races at world-famous Daytona International Speedway during the Roar Before the Rolex 24 weekend. Lee will pilot the #66 Czabok-Simpson Porsche Cayman RS GT4 Clubsport in the GSX class in the series, which also includes LMP3 cars.

The 21-year-old son of NBC Sports announcer Kevin Lee said, "I'm super excited to make the move into the IMSA series with Czabok-Simpson Motorsport and looking forward to the opportunity they have given me. I want to drive as many different types of cars as I can and I know the IMSA platform offers a great experience for me as a driver and commercially for our partners. It's a great time to be taking this step in my career, while still pursuing opportunities in the INDYCAR ladder system. I've known of Stephen from his success in IMSA as a driver and also as a coach and I can't wait to get behind the wheel of the new Porsche."



IMSA Prototype winner and team co-owner, Stephen Simpson says, "I am excited to have Jackson as part of our team and welcome him and his sponsors to our program. I was very keen to give him a shot in one of our Porsches and I have no doubt he will make a good impression- he's fast and smart."

Lee's partners and sponsors include the Indiana University Simon Comprehensive Cancer Center, Race for RP, Browning Chapman: Specialty Contractor Company, Cusick Motorsports, On Track Performance,

and Subway of Hobart/Valparaiso, IN.

Czabok-Simpson Motorsport partner Matthias Czabok said that the team are due to shake down the first of their two brand new Porsche Cayman RS GT4 Clubsports prior to Daytona. The first car is already in preparation under the experienced eye of Luis Perocarpi at their shop in Brownsburg, IN, and they plan to take delivery of the second car before year end. The driver lineups for the team's IMSA Michelin Pilot Challenge program will be announced soon.

Sanctioned by IMSA and usually run as support races for the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship, the series features two 45-minute races per event weekend with no mid-race pit stops or driver changes. Races air live via NBC Sports on Peacock with tape delay airing on CNBC.
